This case was last heard on 12.10.2021 vide which the Respondent / PIO was directed to file a proper reply in the form of an affidavit to the Appellant by the next date of hearing.

In today's hearing, the Appellant, Sh. Jagjit Singh states that no information has been supplied to him.

On the other hand, the Senior Assistant, Sh. Swaran Singh states that they have information relating to two persons i.e. under group A and B.

After going through the case file, it has been observed that the statement given by Senior Assistant, Sh. Swaran Singh on previous hearing dated 12.10.2021 is different from the today's i.e. 21.12.2021. As they have to supply an affidavit but now he is saying something else.

On further discussion with the parties, it has been found that the Senior Assistant, Sh. Swaran Singh doesnot know anything about this case as he is just giving different replies.

Commission takes a serious view of the casual approach of the concerned PIO.

In view of the above, a show cause notice under Section 20 (1) of the RTI Act is issued to the 'concerned' Public Information Officer O/o The District Education Officer (Elementary Education), Ludhiana (Punjab), as to why penalty be not imposed upon him for willful delay in supplying the information to the RTI Appellant and as to why the compensation be not awarded to the informationseeker under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

In addition, the PIO is also hereby given an opportunity under Section 20(1) provision thereto, for a personal hearing with the sought for information, before the imposition of such penalty on the next date of hearing. A copy of the RTI Application dated 28.04.2021 be sent to the concerned PIO along with this order through registered post, so that the facts of this case would be clarified.

The concerned PIO is directed to supply the requisite information to the Appellant by registered post or through email **within 4 weeks positively (along with a copy to the Commission)** and if the information is not available with them then the PIO is directed to file a proper reply in the form of an affidavit explaining the reason, why the information could not be supplied to the Appellant till date, failing which an action would be taken against the concerned PIO.
