After hearing both the parties and going through the record available on file, it is observed that the requisite information has been provided to the appellant to his satisfaction and that the case may be disposed of. Now no further action is required in this case. Therefore, the instant appeal case is **disposed of and closed**. **Copies of the order be sent to the parties**.

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 07.08.2019 vide which the PIO was directed to get the inquiry conducted and repot be submitted regarding dispatch of information to the appellant and refund Rs.25/deposited by the appellant for sending information through registered post. The appellant stated that he has received information regarding points at Sr. No.1 and 2 to his satisfaction but no information regarding points at Sr. No.3 and 4 has been provided to him. He was advised to visit the office of the respondents on 16.8.2019 and get the information on the spot.

- 2. The appellant is absent but he has sent an email dated 21.08.2019 stating that he visited the office of the respondents and has received incomplete information on 21.8.2019.
- 3. The representatives of the respondents submit that they have brought inquiry report about sending the information through ordinary post/registered post. They are ready to refund Rs.25/- received from the appellant because they have sent the information through ordinary post. The respondents have already given information regarding points at Sr. No. 1 and 2 to his satisfaction. They have brought partial information regarding points at Sr. No. 3 and 4, as available in their office, under the provisions of the RTI Act, to be handed over to the appellant during the hearing but the appellant is absent and request that remaining information is available with the Government and appellant should get the same from the Government.
- 4. After hearing the respondents and going through the record available on the case file, it is revealed that as per the version of the respondents, information as available in their record has been sent to the appellant and nothing is left, which could be supplied to the appellant as per his application for seeking information under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005. The respondent is directed to refund Rs.25/- to the appellant (as deposited by him) for providing information through registered post. The instant case is **disposed of** and **closed** with the advice to the appellant to get the remaining information, which is not available with the Punjab Public Service Commission, Patiala from the concerned department/government as per his requirement.
