ORDER:

The appellant, through an RTI application dated 31.08.2021 has sought information on 05 points regarding the Income & expenditure details of Pracheen Saran Mandir Tapa Mandi from 01.04.2006 to 31.03.2021 – income received and expenditure made on the construction of shops in front of trust office as enumerated in the RTI application concerning the office of Manager, Pracheen Saran Mandir Committee, Tappa Mandi, Dsitt Barnala. The appellant was not provided with the information, after which the appellant filed a first appeal before the first appellate authority on 01.10.2021, which did not decide on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Barnala. As per the appellant, the PIO has not supplied the information.

The respondent is absent nor is represented. The Commission has received a reply from the Pracheen Saran Mandir Committee, Tappa Mandi on 20.06.2022 which has been taken on record. In the said reply, it has been mentioned that the respondent is not a public authority and it is a private committee which is not run/managed with the funds provided by the appropriate Government, hence does not fall under the definition of Public Authority under section 2(h) of the RTI Act.

Since the appellant has provided no evidence for the commission to consider evaluation that whether the respondent falls under the definition of public authority, no further interference from the commission is required. Hence, it is assumed that Pracheen Saran Mandi Committee is a private institution and is not covered under the definition of public authority under section 2(h) of the RTI Act 2005, hence rejected.

The case is **closed**.
