

(31. We uphold the said contention and do not find any error in the impugned judgment of the High Court whereby it has been held that the Commissioner while entertaining a complaint under Section 18 of the said Act has no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for access to the information).

In the complaint cases, it is to be seen whether the intention of the respondent-PIO is clear or not.

6. However, regarding misbehave with the complainant, the respondent is directed to show cause in writing or through affidavit under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act.
