

# **ORDER**

- 1. The RTI application is dated 25.02.2020 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 27.05.2020 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 13.07.2020 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 22.09.2020 by the Commission through Video Conferencing. at D.C. Office, Ludhiana. The appellant Shri Jasbir Singh comes present to attend the hearing through V.C. He states that he has applied for renewal of his Driving License which has not been received after renewal so far.
- 3. Shri Piara Singh, Assistant Transport Officer/PIO,O/o S.T.C. Punjab, Chandigarh comes present in person before the Bench to attend the hearing. He states that the requisite action is to be taken by the office of Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Ludhiana. Accordingly, a letter was written to Secretary, R.T.A. Ludhiana to take action as per rules and dispose off the matter and again a reminder has been sent on 16.09.2020.

4. Shri Manish Kumar, PIO O/o Secretary, R.T.A. Ludhiana who is present for the hearing through V.C. states that the appellant has been informed vide letter dated 13.07.2020 that his Driving License is of Transport category and for its renewal, a certificate to the effect that the prescribed refresher course has been done at Mahuana, has to be enclosed with the renewal application. The license of the appellant is pending for want of the said certificate.

5. Post deliberations, it emerges that the appellant is of the view that these procedures are outdated and renewal of his license should happen automatically without the requirement of having to undergone the refresher course as stated by the PIO, R.T.A. Ludhiana. The PIO was emphatic in stating that as per Punjab Government rules, the refresher course is a pre-requisite for the renewal of Driving license. On perusal of the case file, it also emerges that the appellant has filed CWP No.7683 of 2020 in the Hon'ble High Court in this regard which is fixed for hearing on 23.09.2020 and as such, the matter is sub judice.

6. Besides the appellant having filed a CWP in the case and matter being sub-judice, it clearly stands out that the information as available in official documents stands supplied, hence no further action by the Bench is called for. **The appeal case is disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.





ORDER:

- 1. The RTI application is dated 24.06.2020 vide which the complainant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. The complaint was filed in the Commission on 03.08.2020 under Section 18 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 22.09.2020 by the Commission through Video Conferencing facility in the office of D.C. Ludhiana.
- 3. The case has been heard today through V.C. in DC Office, Ludhiana. Shri Trilochan Singh, complainant comes present to attend the hearing. He states that he has not been provided any information as yet.
- 4. Shri Satish Kumar, Assistant Town Planner/APIO, Zone-C, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana attends the hearing. He states that the information, as asked for vide RTI application i.e. copies of the charge sheets issued to the officials concerned, have been supplied. He also hands over to the appellant during the hearing a copy of the written statement filed in the writ petition pending in the Hon'ble High Court.
- 5. On the asking of the Bench, the complainant states that he has sought information from the PIO O/o Municipal Town Planner of Municipal Corporation, whereas the information has been supplied by Zone-C of Municipal Corporation. On the asking of the Bench, the representative of the PIO states that the information sought actually relates to their Branch and as such, he has been deputed by their Branch to handle the case.

- 6. On perusal of case file, the Bench observes that the information asked for by the complainant relates to employees of Municipal Corporation i.e. Assistant Town Planner and Building Inspectors and the same has been provided to the complainant, but the appellant does not seem to be satisfied with the same. It is further ascertained that the complainant has not availed the provision of the Section 19(1) of the RTI Act by filing an appeal with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). As such, the FAA has not been able to address the grievances of the complainant.
- 7. It must be noted that there is an alternate and efficacious remedy of First Appeal available under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act. It appears that the complainant has failed to avail the same in the instant complaint.
- 8. In view of the aforesaid, the instant matter is remanded to the First Appellate Authority i.e. Joint Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana. The Commission hereby directs the FAA to treat the copy of the Complaint (enclosed herewith) as the First Appeal and decide the matter in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act after giving all concerned parties an opportunity to be heard. In case, the complainant is not satisfied with the decision of the First Appellate Authority (FAA), he is at liberty to file second appeal with Punjab State Information Commission in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.
- 9. In view of the above, **the case is disposed off and closed.** Copy of the order be sent to the parties.
