- 1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 07.07.2021 passed by this Bench on the previous date of hearing.
- 2. The case has been heard today. Shri Gurwinder Singh, appellant has not come present to attend the hearing.
- 3. **Shri Satpal Chand, ASI** O/o SSP Fazilka comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench. He states that the appellant has filed a similar RTI application on the same subject matter before the Hon'ble Bench of Shri Asit Jolly, SIC. Complete and adequate information has already been supplied to the appellant in AC No.3090/2020 with which he was satisfied and had given his consent to close the matter and the case was closed by the Bench on 03.02.2021. In the meantime, he filed another RTI application on the same subject matter. He further adds that he has again sent the same information to the appellant vide letter dated 01.05.2021.
