As the RTI request of the appellant should have been transferred to the concerned office within stipulated time under Section 6 (3) of the RTI Act but the proper procedure was not followed by the respondent party, accordingly, the Public Information Officer office of Superintendent, Establishment Branch of office of Director, Local Government, Punjab is directed concerned to supply the certified copies of the required information to the appellant as per queries raised by him through RTI request, through registered post or e-mail with a copy to the Commission by the next date of hearing.

As the respondent PIO of office of Superintendent, Establishment Branch was not exempted from the further hearings of this case, moreover, the respondent PIO or any of representative of office of Superintendent of Establishment Branch is not present in today's hearing. He/She has also not sent any intimation regarding his/her non-availability. The Commission took a serious view of this casual approach of the respondent PIO.

In view of the above, <u>a show cause notice under Section 20 (1) of the RTI Act is</u> <u>issued to Public Information Officer concerned of office of Superintendent, Establishment Branch</u> <u>of office of Director, Local Government, Punjab, as to why penalty be not imposed upon him/her</u> <u>for willful delay/denial in supplying the information to the RTI applicant under the provisions of</u> <u>the RTI Act, 2005.</u>

He/She may note that in case he does not file his/her submission and does not avail himself/herself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date fixed <u>through facility</u> <u>of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings'</u>, it will be presumed that he/she has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceedings against him/her ex-parte. <u>A</u> <u>copy of this order be sent to him through registered post</u>.
