Pursuant to this, the Commission deems it fit to impose a penalty of Rs. 5000.00 on the concerned PIO-cum-ATP, Building Branch, Zone-B, MC, Ludhiana.

Order: Keeping all the facts of the case in mind, this is a fit case to invoke Section 20 of RTI Act and impose a penalty on the respondent PIO Section 20(1), which reads as under:

"Where the Central Information Commission or the State Information Commission, as the case may be, at the time of deciding any complaint or appeal is of the opinion that the Central Public Information Officer or the State Public Information Officer, as the case may be, has, without any reasonable cause, refused to receive an application for information or has not furnished information within the time specified under sub Section (1) of Section 7 or malafidely denied the request for information or knowingly given incorrect, incomplete or misleading information or destroyed information which was the subject of the request or obstructed in any manner in furnishing the information, it shall impose a penalty of 250/- Rupees each day till application is received or information is furnished, so however, the total amount of such penalty shall not exceed Twenty Five Thousand Rupees;

Provided further that the burden of proving that he acted reasonably and diligently shall be on the Central Information Officer, as the case may be."

The onus and responsibility lie on the PIO to ensure the transmission of the complete information to the appellant. The <u>concerned PIO</u>, <u>who was incumbent at the time this RTI application was submitted (21.10.2019)</u>, is hereby held guilty for not providing the information on time as prescribed under Section 7, which is within 30 days of the receipt of the request and for repeated and willful defiance of the Punjab State Information Commission's orders.

A penalty of Rupees Five Thousand (Rs. 5000/-) is hereby imposed upon the <u>concerned PIO</u>, <u>who was incumbent at the time this RTI application was submitted (21.10.2019)</u>, which be deducted from his / her salary and deposited in the Punjab Government Treasury under head "0070-Other Administrative Services-60-other Services-800-Other Receipts-86-Fees Under the Right to Information Act." The <u>concerned PIO</u>, is directed to duly inform the Commission of the compliance of the orders by producing a copy of the challan. Copies of this order be sent to the parties through registered post.

- 3. The respondent PIO is further directed to submit duly attested copies of all the requested information with a covering letter bearing a pointwise reply to the RTI application. This must be sent by registered post to the appellant with a copy to this Commission within 10 days of receipt of this order.
