**ORDER:**

The appellant through an RTI application dated 25.08.2021 has sought information regarding the list of dead persons relating to the Bus Truck accident at Pyar on 03.03.1997 on the basis of which a case was registered in the police station Jandiala on the statement of Jasbir Singh – date of filing case No.43/1997 in the court and other information as enumerated in the RTI application concerning the office of SSP Rural Amritsar. The appellant was not provided with the information after which the appellant filed a first appeal before the first appellate authority on 15.09.2021 which took no decision on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Amritsar. The appellant is absent and vide email has informed that the PIO has not supplied the information.

The respondent present pleaded that since the record is 24 years old and is not traceable, the information cannot be provided.

The Commission, however, does not consider the record missing until an enquiry is conducted and the enquiry report is submitted which establishes that the record stands missing and the responsibility has been fixed for the person under whose custody the record went missing.

The PIO is directed to conduct an enquiry into the matter by constituting a committee and submitting a complete enquiry report which establishes that the record stands missing and the responsibility has been fixed for the persons under whose custody the record went missing.

The case is adjourned. To come up for further hearing on **21.09.2022** at 11.00 AM through video conference facility available in the office of Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar.

**ORDER:**

The appellant through an RTI application dated 22.07.2021 has sought information regarding the list of employees posted in Gumtala chowki from the year 2017 alongwith their name and designation – a copy of the attendance register – complaints received against them – complaints disposed of – pending complaints and other information as enumerated in the RTI application concerning the office of Commissioner of Police Amritsar. The appellant was not provided with the information after which the appellant filed a first appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 24.08.2021 which took no decision on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Amritsar. The Commission has received a reply from the PIO through email which has been taken on record. In the reply, the PIO has mentioned that the information relating to points 1 & 2 cannot be provided as per the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in LPA (Civil No.27734 of 2012 and CC 14727 of 2012 dated 03.10.2012 and the information relating to point 3, 4 & 5 is not covered under the definition of information under section 2(f) of the RTI Act. Hence cannot be provided and the reply has been sent to the appellant vide letter dated 15.09.2021.

The appellant is absent nor is represented to pursue his case.

Having gone through the RTI application, and the reply of the PIO, the following is concluded:
