ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 31.05.2021.

2. The Appellant- Sh Rajwinder Singh states that he has not received the complete information till date. However, he states that he has received the amount of compensation.

3. The Brief facts of the case are that he Appellant had filed his RTI application to the PIO O/o Vigilance Bureau, Amritsar on 02.12.2019. The PIO O/o Vigilance Bureau, Amritsar transferred the RTI application of the Appellant to the PIO O/o Vigilance Bureau, Headquarters, Punjab Mohali as part of the information was lying in their office. Further, the RTI of the Appellant was sent to PIO O/o DGP, Pb, Chandigarh as the information was also related to them. The PIO O/o DGP, Pb transferred the RTI of the Appellant to AIG/Crime Wing, Pb. The PIO O/o AIG/Crime then transferred the RTI of the Appellant to PIO O/o Commissioner of Police, Amritsar.

4. Today, representatives from the above said departments are appearing. Smt Rupinder Kaur, ASI appearing on behalf of PIO O/o Vigilance Bureau, Amritsar states that the available

information has already been provided to the Appellant. She also files an affidavit regarding the same vide Commission diary no. 13384 dated 21.06.2021. Copy of the same is taken on record. They have also sent a CD regarding information in the Commission office. The appellant may collect the same from the Commission office on any working day.

5. Further, Inspector Sukhminder Singh, O/o Vigilance Bureau, Headquarters, Pb Mohali also files his affidavit stating that the available information has been provided to the Appellant and that there is nothing pending in this regard.

6. Sh Gurtej Singh, Supdt. appearing on behalf of PIO O/o DGP, Punjab states that, as directed in the hearing dated 11.02.2021, the enquiry has been finalized regarding compensation. He also files a copy of the final enquiry report. Copy of the same is taken on record.

7. Sh Ram Parshad, ASI appearing on behalf of PIO O/o AIG/Crime, Punjab states that the amount of compensation has been provided to the Appellant. Further, the information is related to PIO O/o Commissioner of Police, Amritsar.

8. Sh Sarwan Singh, Inspector appearing on behalf of Commissioner of Police, Amritsar states that the information, as available, in their official record has been provided to the appellant. They have also filed an affidavit in this regard. Copy of the same is taken on record.

9. After hearing the parties and perusing the documents placed on record, it is ascertained that the final enquiry report has been filed in the Commission office. The amount of compensation has also been provided to the Appellant. The Respondent(s) have filed their replies/affidavits. I have gone through the same and am of the view that the available information has been provided to the Appellant.

10. In view of the foregoing, no further cause of action is let. Therefore, the Appeal case filed by the Appellant is **disposed off and closed**. Copy of the orders be sent to the parties.
