ORDER

Shri Jaj Singh, complainant/applicant filed RTI application dated 06.07.2020 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o BDPO, Rajpura, Distt. Patiala.

Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Facility.

The complainant/applicant is absent today, whereas the respondent is present on behalf of the SPIO and he stated that the complainant/applicant has not deposited the requisite fee of Rs.5,530/- with the office of the SPIO till date.

I have gone through the order dated 12.05.2021 and applicant was directed to deposit the amount of Rs. 5,530/- as assessed fee with the office of the SPIO within a week and the SPIO was further directed to provide the attested copies of information to the appellant within a week from the deposit of assessed fee by the applicant and send compliance to the Commission accordingly.

Today the respondent stated that the complainant-applicant has still not deposited the requisite fee of Rs. 5,530/-.

The complainant/applicant is absent today, and neither he has deposited the assessed fee with the office of the SPIO and nor he has sent any mail to the Commission. It means that he is not interested in getting the sought for information.

So, the present complaint case is **disposed of and closed** with the observation that in case the applicant still wants to get the information, then he should deposit the assessed fee of Rs.5,530/- with the office of the SPIO within 15 days and in case the applicant will deposit the assessed fee then the SPIO should provide him the attested copies of sought for information within a week from the deposit of assessed fee.

Shri Nitin Kumar Garg, appellant filed RTI application dated 25.05.2020 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o SMO, Mukerian.

Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Facility.

Both the parties are present today.

The SPIO stated that the information was sent twice to the appellant.

The appellant stated that he has received the information sent by the SPIO, but the information regarding point no.4 of the RTI application is incomplete as the SPIO has not provided him the list of expenditure on the medicines given to the Covid-19 patients admitted at Civil Hospital, Mukerian.

The SPIO stated that Level-2 facilities are not available at Civil Hospital, Mukerian and no Covid-19 patient is admitted at Civil Hospital, Mukerian, so no expenditure was done on the medicines. He further stated that the said reply is already given to the appellant vide letter no.594 dated 08.06.2021 at point no.4 and a copy of the same has also been sent to the Commission as compliance.
