ORDER:

This case may be read with the reference of the previous order dated 17.05.2022.

In today's hearing, the Appellant, Sh. Jasbir Singh states that no information has been supplied to him till date. On the other hand, none is present from the Department.

Commission takes a serious view of the casual approach of the Respondent / PIO as the Respondent / PIO is absent today and as per the Appellant information is still not supplied to him till date.

In view of the above, a show cause notice under Section 20 (1) of the RTI Act is issued to the 'concerned' Public Information Officer O/o The Panchayat Secretary, Gram Panchayat, Tandi, Bhogpur, District Jalandhar, as to why penalty be not imposed upon him for willful delay in supplying the information to the RTI Appellant and as to why the compensation be not awarded to the informationseeker under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

In addition, the PIO is also hereby given an opportunity under Section 20(1) provision thereto, for a personal hearing with the sought for information, before the imposition of such penalty on the next date of hearing. A copy of the RTI Application be sent to the concerned PIO along with this order through registered post.

The concerned PIO is directed to supply the requisite information to the Appellant by registered post or email before the next date of hearing positively and if the information is not available with them then the PIO is directed to file a proper reply in the form of an affidavit explaining the reason, why the information could not be supplied to the Appellant till date, failing which an action would be taken against the concerned PIO.

The FAA O/o BDPO, Bhogpur, District Jalandhar is directed to look into this matter and make sure the concerned PIO must comply the above said order.

Also, the Appellant, Sh. Jasbir Singh is directed to go through the supplied information, once he receives the same from the Respondent/PIO and point out deficiencies in written, if any, to the Respondent/PIO through registered post or through email, with a copy to the Commission.
