3. The appellant is absent but he has sent the submissions, which are taken on record. However, the respondent-Public Information Officer states that the specific point wise reply regarding sought information has already been sent to the Commission with a copy to the appellant, which has already been taken on record. She further states that the information pertaining to Point No. 1 and 5 of the RTI application has already been supplied to the appellant and Point No. 2,3,4 and 6 of the RTI application has already been transferred to the concerned public authority i.e. PP1 Branch(Point No. 2 of the RTI application) and

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Finance Department (Point No. 3,4 and 6 of the RTI application). Also the Public Information Officer, P.P. 1 Branch states that the specific reply regarding the sought information has already been sent to the appellant vide No. 695 dated 3.8.2021 with a copy to the Commission, which has already been taken on record.

4. Also the RTI application has been considered in terms of the orders issued by the Punjab State Information Commission in CC No. 2177 of 2010 (DOD 2.8.2010) in which it has been mentioned that the information to be collected, collated, tabulated and rearranged is not within the purview of the RTI Act. Subsequently, the office memorandum issued by the Department of Personnel and Training, Government of India vide no. 1/18/2011-IR dated 16.9.2011 in which it has been mentioned that:-

“only such information can be supplied under the Act which already exists and is held by the public authority or held by the public authority or held under the control of the public authority. The Public Information Officer is not supposed to create information or to interpret information or to solve the problems raised by the applicant or to furnish the replies to hypothetical questions”.

5. The RTI application of appellant was also considered in terms of office memorandum issued by the Department of Personnel & Training, Government of India vide No. 11/2/2008-IR dated 10.7.2008 in which it has been stated that the Public Information Officer has to supply the ‘material’ in the form as held by the public authority and it is not required to do research on behalf of the citizen to deduce anything from the material and then supply it to him.

6. It is also appropriate to mention the decision given by the Supreme Court of India in the matter of Central Board of Secondary Education & Anr. Vs. Aditya Bandopadhyay & Ors (Civil Appeal No.6454 of 2011) reported as 2011(3)RCT(Civil) and circulated by the Ministry

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of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Department of Personnel and Training vide No. 1/18/2011-IR dated 16.9.2011 which is as follows:-

“At this juncture, it is necessary to clear some misconceptions about the RTI Act. The RTI Act provides access to all information that is available and existing. This is clear from a combined reading of section 3 and the definitions of ‘information’ and ‘right to information’ under clauses (f) and (j) of section 2 of the Act. If a public authority has any information in the form of data or analysed data, or abstracts, or statistics, an applicant may access such information, subject to the exemptions in section 8 of the Act. But where the information sought is not a part of the record of a public authority, and where such information is not required to be maintained under any law or the rules or regulations of the public authority, the Act does not cast an obligation upon the public authority, to collect or collate such non available information and then furnish it to an applicant. A public authority is also not required to furnish information which require drawing of inferences and/or making of assumptions. It is also not required to provide ‘advice’ or ‘opinion’ to an applicant, nor required to obtain and furnish any ‘opinion’ or ‘advice’ to an applicant. The reference to ‘opinion’ or ‘advice’ in the definition of ‘information’ in section 2(f) of the Act, only refers to such material available in the records of the public authority. Many public authorities have, as a public relation exercise, provide advice, guidance and opinion to the citizens. But that is purely voluntary and should not be confused with any obligation under the RTI Act.”

7. It is also appropriate to mention the instructions issued by the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Department of Personnel & Training No. 10/2/2008-IR dated 12.6.2008 to transfer the RTI application of the appellant under Section 6(3) of the RTI Act,

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2005 to 'public authority' and not to the 'public authorities' in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005. However, the appellant is at liberty to file the application afresh to the authorities concerned in case he is willing to take any information.

8. Keeping in view the above, the Commission observes that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed.

ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 26.10.2021.

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Appeal Case No. 3768 of 2021

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2. The appellant has sought the following information:-

1. Please provide the following authenticated information:-
 - (a) I had made several complaints bearing no 399829,376159 dt 12 July, 382505 dated 23 July, 389603 dated 25 July 2019 and 415618 dated 16/09/2019. Please intimate the daily progress made on my requests registered through Pgrs grievances portal so far. i.e. when did it reach to which officer, for how long did it stay with that officer, and which action taken by the concerned officer and reply given to applicant?

Latest complaint 420981 on pgrsig.punjab dated 08 Feb 2020 details forwarded to sh Gurinder singh and Varinder Singh as mentioned on site. In this regard please provide details what action has been taken so far since the roads are still as it is.
 - (i) Letters dated 13 Sept 19, 14 Sept 19 and 14 Oct 2019 were forwarded through registered post & by hand from Shree Devaji Residency kisanpura. When did these applications reach which officer, for how long did it stay with that officer, and which action taken and reply given to applicant? Please also provide copy of page of entries in dak receipt register with serial no and date, where these applications have been entered.
 - (b) Please provide the address of National consumer Dispute Redressal commission, Punjab, Copy of completion certificate, copy of necessary approval taken by developer/builder in respect of Shree Devaji Residency Kisanpura, commencement certificate, building and section plan (elevation & S), copy of original plan approved in respect of shree Devaji Residency, Kisanpura. Please also confirm which officers are responsible to take action for these actions.
 - (c) Please provide/intimate the responsibility of office and officer/individual to take action to fill the pot holes on roads, which are fallen within the vicinity. MS enclave to village Kisanpura and peermuchalla. Please intimate the course of action and time limits on complaints received by your office. Which action is required to be taken as per CCS conduct rules against the individual concerned for not completing the task and negligence in duties? Copy of reports submitted by concerned officers on the complaints regarding pot holes and logging of water.
 - (d) Please intimate what/which action is required to be taken by the MC/EO to take over Shree Devaji Residency Kisanpura, Dhakoli and who is responsible for irregularities if any, due to which residents are facing lack of basic facilities like street lights, pure water etc as per MC bye laws.
 - (e) Please intimate the names, designations, Mobile Numbers and section/department of dealing employees, who issued fit out certificate in respect of Shree Devaji Residency, Friends enclave, Green valley etc.
 - (f) Please provide information that many pit holes, broken road due to sewage connection taken from road and storm water is logging on main road near vatenary hospital and Sushma Project on the way at Kisanpura to MS Enclave. Please inform what action has been taken on internet complaints lodged through mobile No 9855488504 at pgrs portal. How much time is required to solve/resolve the complaint? If the concerned officer has not taken action to do

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- his job for which he is responsible then what liabilities are required to be fixed against the concerned officer/staff. Also provide copies of minule sheets or notes/ warnings/advisory issued in hierarchy.
- (g) Please provide copy of orders for fulfillment of procedural requirements of works disseminated to concerned staff like course of action and time limit.
- (h) Please intimate how much expenditure incurred during repair, filling of pot holes, on roads from MS enclave to cozy home to Kisanpura during June 2019 to Nov 2019 alongwith authenticated copies of vouchers/bills.
- (i) Please confirm who is responsible to repair the road after taking sewage connection from the main road and what are the procedural requirements to repair. What action has been taken and directions issued to repair the roads after sewage connections? Also confirm how much charges required to be taken for sewage connection and repair of road by MC from shop owner.
- (j) It is seen that three four shops have been constructed during last three months on the corner near scooter mechanic shop of MS enclave. Please intimate how much wide road is required to be left in front of shops for parking purpose on this road as per MC bye laws. When did the maps of these shops have been passed and constructed or which officer was detailed to check the construction. Whether directions for completion certificate etc has been issued to these shops. How much drawings/maps have been passed for shops within one kilometer on main road near scooter mechanic shop at MS enclave to Kisanpura village. Whether the bye laws has been opted while passing the maps of these shops. Which officer was detailed to check out whether the shops were constructed as per MC Bye Laws. Please provide a copy of report submitted by the officer concerned alongwith his designation and name.
- (k) Please intimate who is responsible to stop the encroachments on roads from MS enclave to Kisanpura/ peemuchhala. Please confirm the name and designation of officer as detailed to check and stop the irregularities of commercial activities as well as domestic. As it can be seen that flat owners are frequently running commercial activities in parkings on main road. Please confirm which action has been taken by the concerned officer who is liable to stop such type of activities.
- (l) Please provide a copy of calculation sheet of floors signed by Architect, Tax Assessment with tax paid receipts alongwith location of rain harvesting plant, sewage treatment plant in respect of Shree Devaji Residency Kisanpura, Dhakoli as the same was passed & regularized by MC/EO.
- (m) Please provide a copy of sanctioned plan, reports on construction according to the approved building plan, copy of checking reports, which meets necessary standard set by MC/EO, alongwith liability of concerned officer and authenticated copy of reports submitted by officers.
- (n) Copy of approved layout plan in respect of shree devaji residency Kisanpura.
- (o) Please intimate the name, designation, mobile numbers, email id of the officers who are liable to issue fire safety certificates, occupation/completion certificates,
- (p) Please intimate the actions taken by MC/EO on requisite structure of colony and fire safety etc. alongwith the name of officer, designation and phone Number responsible to do/check these jobs.
- (q) Please provide name, designation, mobile no, email id and official address of MC officers in hierarchy, who are responsible to resolve the issues. Also
- Intimate the name designation, email id mobile no and address of Director local bodies Punjab.

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3. The representative of the respondent states that the complete information as available on record has already been supplied to the appellant with which the appellant agreed to. The appellant further states that he has no objection if the present case is disposed of.

ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 4.10.2021.

2. The appellant has sought the following information:-

- i. Certified copies of records of ownership of streets of the town by the MC which is constructed or reconstructed and drainage/sewage constructed/reconstructed after 1-1-2015 through tenders or quotations. Kindly also provide certified copies of records of transfer of street land in the name of MC by the residents on the street.
- ii. Certified copies of records of ownership of streets of Mohalla Atam Nagar on Tehsil road opp. Govt. Sr. Secondary School Jagraon by the MC which is constructed or reconstructed and drainage/sewage constructed/reconstructed after 1-1-2015 through tenders or quotations. Kindly also provide certified copies of records of transfer of street land in the name of MC by the residents on the street.
- iii. Certified copies of record of ownership of street No 7 of Mohalla Atam Nagar on Tehsil road opp. Govt. Sr. Secondary School Jagraon and its transfer to MC Jagraon.

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Appeal Case No. 577 of 2021

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- Certified copies of Public money spent on it including Agenda of MC, Resolution passed by the MC, Tenders floated, Tenders accepted, Work Permit given, MB book regarding measurement, Record of payment made to contractors.
- iv. Certified details name of President, EO, SO and ME/AME responsible of construction/reconstruction of streets and sewer/drainage lines on streets not owned by Municipal Council. Provide copies of resolution of house, copy of estimate, copy of work permit, copy of MB Book regarding the particular job and completion certificates of streets and sewage lines.
 - v. Certified copies of record of law, rules, directions, orders etc. vide which construction/reconstruction of streets and sewer/drainage lines on streets not owned by Municipal Council could be done.
 - vi. Certified copies of record of law, rules, directions, orders etc. vide which action is to be initiated against concerned officials/Councillors/president of MC for construction/reconstruction of streets and sewer/drainage lines on streets not owned by Municipal Council could be done.
 - vii. Certified copies of quantum of punishment, penalty, recovering public money from concerned officials/Councillors/president of MC for construction/reconstruction of streets and sewer/drainage lines on streets not owned by Municipal Council could be done. In case any action has been done so far, please provide copies of complete records concerning that action.
 - viii. Certified copies of record of law, rules, directions, orders etc. vide which action is to be initiated against private person for construction/reconstruction of streets and sewer/drainage lines on public.
 - ix. *Since the information pertains to attack on RTI Activist and Journalist (complainant), the complaint is facing threat of life and liberty from the accused and the police itself, the same be provided within 48 hours from the receipt of this application as prescribed U/s 7 (1) that states " where the information sought for concerns the life or liberty of a person, the same shall be provided within forty-eight hours of the receipt of the request."*
 - x. In case part of the information sought by the applicant pertains to some other PIO, the application be transferred to him U/s 6 (3) of RTI Act, 2005.
 - xi. Kindly provide an appointment to verify the original records pertaining to information sought after providing the information.

3. The appellant states that directions may be issued to the respondent Public Information Officer to supply the complete information in this case. However the representative of the respondent states that the appellant has not appeared before the First Appellate Authority in spite of the written intimation sent to the appellant in this regard.

4. Keeping in view the submissions made by the respondent and after the perusal of the record of the case file, the titled appeal case of the appellant is remanded to the First Appellate Authority with the direction to pass the speaking order in this case after hearing the parties concerned within the stipulated period as per the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005. Also the appellant is directed to remain present before the First Appellate Authority after getting the intimation in this regard. With these directions, the case is disposed of and closed. However the liberty is granted to the appellant to approach the Commission in case he is not satisfied with the decision of the First Appellate Authority for the consideration of the Commission.

3. The appellant is absent but he has sent the submissions through email and by post, which are taken on record. However, the representative of the respondents already supplied the information pertaining to Point No. 3, 4 & 5 of the RTI application vide letter dated 9.9.2021. Also regarding the remaining information regarding Point No. 1 of the RTI application, the respondent also filed the specific reply vide letter dated 23.11.2021 with a copy to the appellant that Sh. Jagsir Singh joined as Patwari at Zira on 23.3.1991 as has been sought by the appellant. Regarding Point No. 2 of the RTI application, the respondent submitted vide letter dated 23.11.2021 that the information pertaining to the 3rd party and is also exempted in accordance with the instructions issued by the Government of Punjab dated 9.8.2021 as per the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The relevant portion of the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No. 10044 of 2010 titled Central Public Information Officer, Supreme Court of India Vs Subhash Chandra Agarwal is reproduced below:-

“Reading of the aforesaid judicial precedents, in our opinion, would indicate that personal records, including name, address, physical, mental and psychological status, marks obtained, grades and answer sheets, are all treated as personal information. Similarly, professional records, including qualification, performance, evaluation reports, ACRs, disciplinary proceedings, etc. are all personal information. Medical records, treatment, choice of medicine, list of hospitals and doctors visited, findings recorded, including that of the family members, information relating to assets liabilities, income tax returns, details of investments, lending and borrowing, etc. are personal information. Such personal information is entitled to protection from unwarranted invasion of privacy and conditional access is available when stipulation of larger public interest is satisfied.”

4. Keeping in view the above, the Commission observes that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed. Since, the appellant is absent, therefore, the opportunity is granted to file the submissions, if any, in this case, within four weeks for the consideration of the Commission.
