ORDER

Heard through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings'.
The RTI request is dated 01.12.2020. First appeal is dated 29.05.2021. Second appeal has been received in the Commission on 13.07.2021.

The above-mentioned has earlier heard by the bench of the then Hon'ble State Information Commissioner, Sh. Hem Inder Singh on 21.10.2021. Hon'ble Chief Information Commissioner vide Office Order dated 03.01.2022, has re-allocated the case to the Bench of the undersigned for further hearing/hearings. Accordingly, the case is fixed for hearing for today i. e. 24.01.2022.

On the last date of hearing, held on 21.10.2021 ;

- i) The appellant intimated that no information was given to him by the respondent PIO.

Hem Inder Singh), a reply dated 07.01.2022 in an affidavit (Duly attested by Notary) signed by Joint Director(Crime)-cum-PIO, Vigilance Bureau, Punjab, has been given to the appellant vide letter no. 863 dated 07.01.2022 through registered post. She also intimates the Commission that a reply has also been sent to the Commission vide letter no. 864 dated 07.01.2022, which has been received in the Commission vide Diary No. 464 dated 10.01.2022. It, alongwith a copy of affidavit, is taken on record.

The appellant, Sh. Prem Kumar Rattan, who appeared in person in today's hearing, expresses his dis-satisfaction over the same.

The RTI request is dated 07.04.2021. First appeal is dated 17.05.2021. Second appeal has been received in the Commission on 09.07.2021.

The above-mentioned has earlier heard by the bench of the then Hon'ble State Information Commissioner, Sh. Hem Inder Singh on 21.10.2021. Hon'ble Chief Information Commissioner vide Office Order dated 03.01.2022, has re-allocated the case to the Bench of the undersigned for further hearing/hearings. Accordingly, the case is fixed for hearing for today i. e. 24.01.2022.

On the last date of hearing, held on 21.10.2021 ;

- i. The appellant was advised to point-out deficiencies, if any, in the supplied information within fifteen days (i. e. from the date 21.10.2021).
- ii. The respondent PIO was directed to supply the certified copies of the information, after removing the deficiencies, to the appellant.

Neither the respondent PIO nor any of his representative is present in today's hearing.
