O R D E R

The above mentioned Case stands allocated to the Bench of Shri Avtar Singh Kaler, Hon'ble State Information Commissioner. Since Shri Avtar Singh Kaler, SIC is on medical leave, therefore, this case is being heard by the undersigned in view of the Office Order dated 08.02.2021.

Shri Bhupinder Singh, appellant filed RTI application dated 24.08.2020 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o Secretary, School Education, Punjab, Mohali. When no information was provided to him by the SPIO then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority. Then he filed Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 08.10.2020. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today to be heard through **CISCO Webex Meetings Software.**

The appellant is present today, whereas none has come present on behalf of the SPIO. The appellant stated that the information sought by him has been denied by the SPIO being third party information.

The Commission has received an e-mail sent by the office of Asstt. Director (S.A.-2), O/o DPI (Secondary), Punjab, SAS Nagar, which is a copy of letter no. 70664 dated 23.02.2021 along with copy of letter no.2020270979-83 dated 29.10.2020, copy of letter no. 2020275453-455 dated 03.11.2020 and copy of letter no. 2969-70 dated 03.12.2020. I have gone through the above said letters and the information sought by the appellant has been denied U/s 8(1)(j) of the RTI Act, 2005 being the third party information.

I have gone through the RTI application filed by the appellant and he sought attested copies of certificates and first page of service book of different Masters/Lecturers as enlisted in the RTI application.

As the information sought by the appellant is regarding the personal information of the Masters/Lecturers, which is third party information as envisaged U/s 8(1)(j) of the RTI Act, 2005. Hence, the RTI application filed by the appellant is dismissed and the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed**.

Therefore, the attention of the complainant is drawn to the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India rendered in its order dated 12.12.2011 in Civil Appeal Nos. 10788 of 2011 (arising out of SLP (C) No. 32768-32769/2010) in para 31 whereof, it has been held that while entertaining a complaint case under Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information. The complainant is advised to approach the first appellate authority in this behalf.
