After examining the documents placed in the case-file record, it is found that the respondent has also sent a reply vide letter no. 38 dated 23.04.2019, signed by O/o The Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Bathinda (Punjab), which has been received in the Commission through an e-mail dated 24.04.2019, intimating the Commission that due to election duty he is unable to attend today's hearing and has requested for an adjournment in this case. It is taken on record.

Today, none is present on behalf of the PIO of office of Sub Divisional Magistrate, Maur, who was impleaded as a party in this case vide orders dated 30.01.2019. Respondent has also not sent any intimation regarding his non-availability. The Commission took a serious view of this casual approach of the Respondent/ PIO.

In view of the above, a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) is imposed upon PIO of office of Sub Divisional Magistrate, Maur for holding guilty of violation under Section 20 (1) as per provisions of the RTI Act.

As the above-mentioned cases i. e. AC: 3917/2018, 3921/2018, 3923/2018, 3925/2018 and 3928/2018 are clubbed, hence, Rs. 5000/- may be collectively deposited for all the five cases.
