The respondent PIO is also directed to supply the information, which would be identified by the appellant, to him during his visit to respondent's office.

Both the parties mutually agreed to it during the hearing today.

An opportunity is also given to the appellant to confirm whether he has received the remaining information or not and also to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO well in time so that the same could be removed by the respondent concerned.

The case is <u>adjourned to 16th August, 2021 (Monday) at 11:00 A. M. for hearing through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings'.</u>

- iii) An opportunity was also given to the complainant to confirm whether he has received the information and also to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO well in time so that the same could be removed by the respondent concerned.
- iv) For making delay in supplying the requisite information to the information-seeker under Section 20 (1) of the RTI Act, a penalty of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) was imposed upon the concerned Public Information Officer of General Manager, Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Bathinda.

Sh. Davinder Jaura, Executive Engineer of office of Municipal Corporation, Bathinda, appeared in today's hearing.

The complainant, Sh. Sanjeev Goyal, who appeared in person in today's hearing, states that incomplete information has been given to him by the respondent PIO office of General Manager, Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Bathinda.

Last opportunity is also given to the respondent-PIO concerned of office of General Manager, Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Bathinda, to supply the legible and certified copies of the required information, to the complainant with a copy to the Commission by the next date of hearing positively. He is also directed to represent this case in person or through his representative on the next date fixed for hearing through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings' to clear the facts of this case.

An opportunity is also given to the complainant to confirm whether he has received the information, which would be supplied to him by the respondent PIO, or not and also to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO well in time so that the same could be removed by the respondent concerned.

After examining the documents placed on record, it emerges that the respondent PIO concerned has not complied with the orders dated 01.03.2021 passed by the Commission, through which penalty of Rs. 10,000/- was imposed upon the concerned Public Information Officer.

The RTI request is dated 19.05.2020. First appeal is dated 29.06.2020. Second appeal has been received in the Commission on 26.08.2020.

On the last date of hearing, held on 08.03.2021,

- i) The respondent PIO through a reply vide letter no. 1508 dated 21.01.2021 had intimated the Commission that in response to the RTI request, the requisite information was supplied to the appellant. It is taken on record.
- ii) The appellant stated that he received information only at point no. 03 and 20 of the RTI request and pointed out deficiencies through letter dated 08.02.2021.

Another opportunity is given to the respondent PIO concerned to supply the remaining information to the appellant with a copy to the Commission by the next date of hearing. He is also directed to represent this case in person or through his representative on the next date fixed for hearing through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings' to clear the facts of this case.

For making delay in supplying the requisite information to the information-seeker under Section 20 (1) of the RTI Act, a penalty of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) is imposed upon the concerned Public Information Officer of office of Executive Engineer, P.W.D. (B & R), Construction Division - 2, Amritsar. A copy of this order be sent to him through registered post.
