ORDER:

- 1. The RTI application is dated **22.6.2020** vide which the appellant has sought information regarding FIRs registered in cases of desecration of Sri Guru Granth Sahib, as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **26.6.2020** and second appeal was filed in the Commission on **2.7.2020** under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005. Notice was issued to the parties for first hearing in the Commission on **24.2.2021**.
- 2. The appellant is absent but has informed the Commission that he has received the requested information. The respondent PIO, represented by ASI Manjeet Singh, present through Video Conference Facility at Deputy Commissioner's Office Sri Muktsar Sahib, also stated that the information sought by the appellant was supplied to him vide letter No. 263/RTI dated 8.7.2020.
- 3. It is notable here that the appellant has sought information regarding number of FIRs pertaining to desecration of Sri Guru Granth Sahib in Sri Muktsar Sahib District. He had sought the information within 48 hours incorrectly claiming it was a matter of "Life and Liberty". The respondent PIO has also pointed out that the requested information does not qualify as a matter of "Life and Liberty" and that it was supplied to the appellant within the 30 days stipulated period under the RTI Act 2005.
- 4. There is no further cause for action and this appeal case is herewith **CLOSED**.

The RTI application is dated **10.2.2020** vide which the appellant has sought information regarding a February 2020 application by one Baljraj Singh against one Gopal Dass, as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **16.3.2020** and second appeal was filed in the Commission on **2.6.2020** under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005. Notice was issued to the parties for first hearing in the Commission on **24.2.2021**.
- 2. The appellant is absent without intimation. The respondent PIO, represented by ASI Manjeet Singh, present through Video Conference Facility at the Deputy Commissioner's Office in Sri Muktsar Sahib, stated that a reply along with the requested information was sent to the appellant by registered post vide Letter No. 3981/C dated: 22.2.2021.
