### Complaint Case No. 1136 of 2018

Present : None on behalf of the complainant.  
Sh. Harivansh, Data Entry Operator, on behalf of the respondent.

#### ORDER

Heard through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings'.

The RTI request is dated 28.08.2018. The complaint has been received in the Commission on 23.10.2018.

On the last date of hearing, held on 26.10.2020, Sh. Baljit Singh, Section Officer, stated that bill regarding due payment (regarding which the information has been demanded through RTI request) is deposited in District Treasury Office, Bathinda. But the respondent had not sent any reply/ document to the Commission, which shows that reply to the RTI request has been given to the complainant. Accordingly, last opportunity was given to the respondent PIO to file a point wise reply to each and every query, raised by the complainant through his RTI request with supporting documents to the Commission as well as to the complainant.
