<u>ORDER</u>

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 18.02.2019 vide which a show cause notice was issued to the respondent –PIO.

2. The appellant filed six appeals with the Commission seeking information from PIO, o/o DC, Ferozepur as in all the six appeals, the appellant and the PIO is the same so all these has been clubbed together

3. Sh. Sunil Kumar the appellant has authorized Sh. Jagdish to appear on his behalf. He states that the appellant has received incomplete information so far.

4. The respondent – PIO is absent for third consecutive hearing.

5. After hearing the appellant and gone through the case file, it is observed that the appellant has received incomplete information so far. The appellant Sh. Sunil Kumar has filed RTI with the department on 05.07.2018, after lapse of more than eight months incomplete information has been given to him so far. Even, the respondent has not bothered to attend any hearing in the Commission.

6. It is, thus apparent from the response of the PIO that there has been delay in providing the information. Appellant had also suffered financial loss in getting the information. There are systemic deficiencies in the manner of receiving and disposing of applications. The department still does not appear to be properly tuned to the performance of its obligations enshrined under the RTI Act. The departmental officials are not properly sensitized and trained to discharge their functions under the RTI Act 2005.

7. I am, therefore, of the view that the Appellant deserves to be awarded compensation under Section 19(8)(b) of RTI Act 2005 for the loss and detriment suffered by him on account of delayed supply of information.

8. I am of the view that ends of justice would be met by awarding a sum of Rs. **5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only)** by way of compensation to the Appellant. This amount shall be payable by State Exchequer within fifteen days.

9. Respondent may take note that this is the last opportunity given to appear before the Commission, otherwise bailable warrant will be issued.




