

- ii) Accordingly, PIO office of Executive Officer Nagar Council, Jagraon, was impleaded as necessary party in this case with the directions either to supply the required information or send a reply to the query/queries (whichever relates to office of Nagar Council, Jagraon) raised by the appellant through his RTI request (copy attached) to him with a copy to the Commission.

None came present from office of Director, Deptt. of Local Government, Punjab, Chandigarh.

Sh. Hira Singh, Clerk office of Executive Officer Nagar Council, Jagraon, who appeared in today's hearing, states that the appellant was advised to visit the office to identify the required information but he did not visit the office till date.

The appellant, Sh. Rahul Gupta, is not present in today's hearing.

Nevertheless, the appellant is advised to visit the office of the respondent PIO to inspect the relevant official record on 25.05.2022 at 12:00 noon to identify the information.

The respondent PIO concerned is directed to facilitate the appellant to inspect the relevant official record during his visit to the office on 25.05.2022 at 12:00 and supply the required information to the appellant (which would be identified by him after inspection) with a copy to the Commission.

An opportunity is also given to the appellant to confirm whether he has received the information, which would be supplied to him by the respondent PIO after inspection, or not and also to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO well in time so that the same could be removed by the respondent concerned by the next date of hearing or the case would be decided on merits..

As in the RTI request is addressed to PIO office of Director, Deptt. of Local Government, Punjab, Chandigarh, hence, a copy of this order be sent to him through registered post with the directions to ensure presence of the concerned PIO to clear the facts of this case.

The concerned parties i. e. i) the appellant and PIOs of office of (ii) Executive Officer Nagar Council, Jagraon and iii) Director, Deptt. of Local Government, Punjab, Chandigarh, are directed to represent this case in person or through their representative on the next date fixed through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings' so that facts of this case could be cleared or the case would be decided on merits.
