The respondent stated that the information sought by the appellant was sent to her vide letter no.939 dated 10.12.2019 and then again vide letter no.1602 dated 11.09.2020.

I have gone through the Order dated 17.11.2020 and 04.03.2021 vide which the appellant was directed to submit the deficiencies in writing to the notice of the SPIO.

The respondent stated that the appellant has not submitted any deficiencies to the notice of the SPIO till date.
