

#### **ORDER**

- 1. The RTI application is dated 10.08.2020 vide which the complainant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. The complainant filed a complaint in the Commission on 18.08.2021 under Section 18 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for hearing through CISCO WEBEX for 10.03.2022, which was postponed and further fixed for 25.5.2022 i.e. today.
- 3. In today's hearing, the complainant is absent and in spite of knowing the date of hearing.
- 4. The respondent states that the information sought for by the complainant has already been provided to the complainant on 25.06.2021 and no deficiency has been pointed out by him till date.
- 5. After going through the file, It is observed that hearing notices dated 21.09.2021 and 04.03.2022, which were issued to the complainant returned to the Commission with remarks 'insufficient address' as wrong father name and phone number was mentioned in the hearing notices inadvertently. A copy of this order be sent to him through registered post with correct details as per the case file
- 6. As the instant case is the complaint case. Despite of being a complaint case, respondent PIO had already been sent o demanded information on 25.06.2021 and till date no communication is received from him after filing the complaint in the Commission.

7. The attention of the Complainant is drawn to the decision of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India rendered on 12.12.2011 in Civil Appeal Nos. Nos.10787 – 10788 of 2011 (arising

out of SLP © No.32768-32769/2010)- Chief Information Commissioner and another Vs. State of

Manipur and another, in Para 31 whereof, it has been held that while entertaining a complaint case

under Section 18 of the RTI Act , 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order

providing for an access to the information which is as under:-

(31. We uphold the said contention and do not find any error in the impugned judgment of the High

Court whereby it has been held that the Commissioner while entertaining a complaint under Section 18

of the said Act has no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for access to the information).

8. As such, since the complainant has approached the Commission under the provision of Section 18

of the RTI Act, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the

Commission.

9. Since there is an alternative and efficacious remedy of first appeal available to the Complainant

under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, which has not been availed in the instant case and the

First Appellate Authority has not had the occasion to review the decision of the PIO, as envisaged

under the RTI Act by passing a detailed well reasoned speaking order. In case the complainant

has any grouse, he is advised to challenge the response of the PIO before the designated First

Appellate Authority, as envisaged under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, who will decide the

matter in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act within the prescribed time limit, after giving

an opportunity of hearing to all concerned, by passing a speaking order.

10. If, however, the complainant does not feel satisfied with the decision of the First Appellate

Authority, he will be at liberty to file a Second Appeal before the Commission under Section 19(3)

of the RTI Act, 2005.

11. In view of the observations noted above, the instant case is disposed of. Copies of this decision

be sent to the parties through registered post.
