ORDER:

The case was first heard on 19.08.2021. The respondents informed that the information has been supplied to the appellant.

-	Point-12	-	Information provided
-	Point-13	-	To provide list of complaints recd u/s 498 IPC
-	Point-14	-	To provide the information
-	Point-15	-	To provide names, designation, postings & tenure only
-	Point-16	-	Allowed to inspect the record after the above information has been given.

On the date of last hearing on **23.08.2021**, the respondent informed that the complete information as available in the record has been provided to the appellant and no further information is available in the record. The respondent also sent a reply through email which was taken on the file of the Commission.

The appellant was not satisfied and informed vide email that information on points 5,6,7&8 has not been provided and the information on point 10 & 11 is incomplete.

Since there was a constant disagreement between what has been provided by the PIO and what has been sought by the appellant, the PIO was directed to file an affidavit on the matter stating that the information that has been provided is true, complete and no other information relating to this RTI application is available in the record. The affidavit should be on a stamp paper duly signed by the PIO.
