ORDER:

*(To be read in continuity with earlier orders on 17.9.2020 and 6.11.2020)*

1. The RTI application is dated **26.6.2019** vide which the appellant has sought information regarding the theft of his Motor Cycle No. PB 02 BD 0843, as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **3.8.2019**, and second appeal was filed in the Commission on **15.1.2020** under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005. The case was last heard on **6.11.2020**.

2. Both parties are present through Video Conference from, Amritsar. At the last hearing on 6.11.2020, the respondent PIO was directed to email a copy of the reply and untraced report sent to the appellant, to this Commission within five days. A copy of the PIOs reply along with a copy of the FIR and untraced report was received on 10.11.2020 vide letter No. 1287/RTI dated 18.3.2020. In view of the written submission sent by the appellant on 24.11.2020 this Commission has carefully re-examined the 24 points listed in his RTI application.

3. This Commission understands that the appellant is agitated over the loss of his son's motorcycle which was reported vide FIR No. 63/19 at Police Station C Division Amritsar. However, the respondent PIO has successively supplied all the documents/information pertaining to the loss of said motor cycle and FIR thereon to the appellant. It is the considered view of this Commission that the appellant's RTI application has been adequately addressed.

4. There is no further cause for action and this appeal case is herewith CLOSED.
