On further discussion with the parties, it has been decided by the undersigned that the Appellant will visit the concerned after deciding a date and time with PIO, Sh. Jasbir Singh through phone call during working days in the coming 3-4 weeks.

In view of above, the Appellant is directed to visit the concerned office (i.e. date and time would be decided by the parties themselves) for collecting the information as per his RTI application. The PIO and other concerned officials are directed to be present there at the time of inspection on the decided date and time.

If the Appellant or his representative would not visit the concerned office on said date and time then it would be presumed that he doesnot requires the information anymore and the case would be decided on merits.

If the inspection couldnot take place from the department's end on the said date and time then an action would be taken against the PIO on the next date of hearing.

This case is adjourned to 02.12.2022 at 11 a.m. for hearing.
