The Drawing and Disbursing Officer O/o AIGP, BOI, Pb. is directed to deduct the amount of penalty of Rs. 10000/- from the salary of the PIO O/o AIGP, BOI, Pb and deposited in the State Treasury in the following Head of Account and to report its compliance to the Commission: -
