

He again visited on 18.07.2022 and again he was not entertained. He also shows to the Bench the documents supplied and states that the same have been supplied unattested by the PIO.

4. Post deliberations, the Bench directs the PIO to call the appellant again to his office and allow him access to the relevant official records and then provide point-wise information, as is identified by the appellant after inspection of records, duly attested by the PIO. Thereafter, he is directed to file an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper, duly signed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information as available in AC No.1621/2020, has been supplied to the appellant. It be further stated that nothing has been concealed therein and the information supplied is true and correct. Appellant has been permitted inspection of case related documents. Original affidavit along with its copy be brought along and produced before the Bench on the next hearing.


