COMPLAINT CASE NO. 1214 OF 2021

PRESENT: None the complainant

ORDER:

The complainant, through an RTI application dated 16.07.2021, has sought information that whether seniority for blind employees working as Asstt. Professors was made - to supply of complete list seniority list for the blind employees working as Asstt. Professor in the state of Punjab and other information as enumerated in the RTI application from the Director Public Instructions(Colleges) Punjab. On not receiving the information, the complainant filed a complaint in the Commission.

The case was heard on 09.12.2021 by the bench of Shri Hem Inder Singh, State Information Commissioner, Punjab, who demitted his office on 22.12.2021. The PIO was absent. However, the PIO was directed to submit a written reply on the next date of hearing.

The case has been reallocated to the undersigned Bench.

Hearing dated 26.07.2022:

The case has come up for hearing today. Both the parties are absent.

Having gone through the RTI application and record in the file, the Commission observes that the respondent vide letter received in the Commission 23.05.2022 stated that available information has already been provided to the complainant vide letter dated 02.02.2022. The letter is taken on record.

This is a Complaint Case. Therefore, at this juncture, it is relevant to invite the attention of the complainant to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India rendered on 12-12-2011 in Civil Appeal Nos. 10788 of 2011 (arising out of SLP © No. 32768-32769/2010) in para 31 whereof, it has been held that while entertaining a complaint case under Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information. Since the complainant has approached the Commission under the provisions of Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission.

An alternative and efficacious remedy of the first appeal is available to the complainant under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, which has not been availed in the instant case. The complainant is advised to approach the first appellate authority on this behalf by citing this order. The First Appellate Authority is directed to decide the case within 45 days.

The case is **disposed of and closed**.

ORDER:

The appellant, through an RTI application dated 06.08.2020, has sought information reg. disclose the university rules under which DAV management New Delhi neither affiliated to the Panjabi University nor aided university, has issued the advertisement in the Tribune dated 05.08.2020 inviting applications for the post of Principal DAV College, Bathinda and other information as enumerated in the RTI application from the Registrar, Panjabi University, Patiala. On not receiving the information, the appellant filed a first appeal to the First Appellate Authority on 05.10.2020, which took no decision, after which, the appellant filed a second appeal in the Commission.

The case was heard on 13.07.2021, 22.09.2021, 14.10.2021 and 14.10.2021 by the bench of Shri Hem Inder Singh, State Information Commissioner, Punjab, who demitted his office on 22.12.2021. On the last hearing date the Bench directed the appellant to point out the deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied.

The case has been reallocated to this Bench.

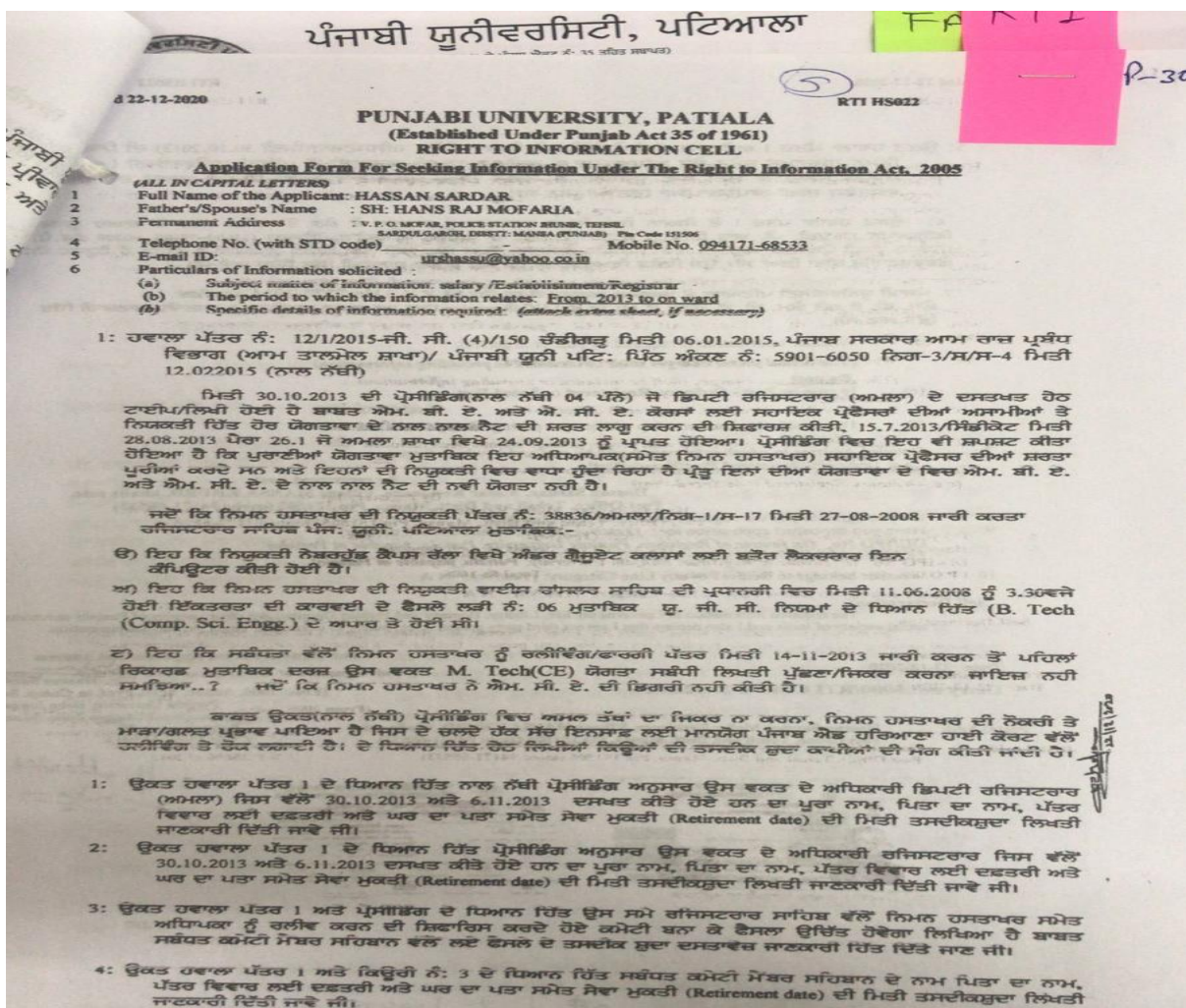

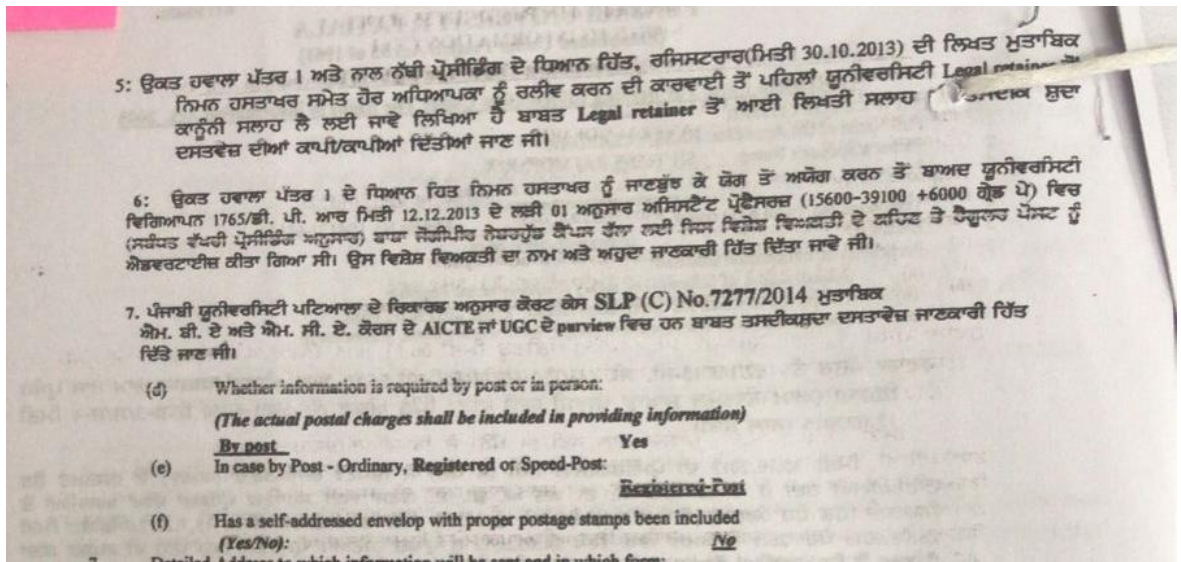
APPEAL CASE NO. 4267 OF 2021

ORDER:

The appellant, through an RTI application dated 20.05.2021, has sought information on 5 points as under :-





The appellant filed first appeal with the First Appellate Authority on 28.06.2021 who took no decision to supply the information after which the appellant filed the second appeal in Commission.

The case first came up for hearing on 01.12.2021 through cisco Webex in the bench of Shri Hem Inder Singh, State Information Commissioner Punjab, who has demitted his office on 22.12.2022. The representative of the PIO pleaded that available information has been supplied to the appellant on 18.10.2021, and the representative of the PIO further pleaded that information of point-1 & 2 being third party cannot be supplied. The case was reallocated to the bench of the undersigned.

Hearing dated 26.07.2021:

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Mansa/Patiala. The respondent present pleaded that the requisite information had been supplied to the appellant vide letters dated 19.08.2021, 18.10.2021 and 28.01.2022.
