3. Respondent, Sh. Surinder Singh pleaded that the sought information enumerated in RTI application is **pending** in the office deputy Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. An email dated 24.10.2020 has been received from respondent wherein the same is mentioned in detail. This email is taken on record with all supporting enclosures.
4. Appellant is absent without any intimation to the Commission.
5. From a perusal of the relevant case records, it is observed that the disclosure of information, in cases under investigation by the police is exempted, according to the provisions of Sections 8(1)(g) and 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act. **It is justified not to disclose information in cases of ongoing police investigations (which have not yet been completed), because such a disclosure could hamper the investigation process.** In view of this, the exemption claimed U/S 8(1)(h) from disclosure of information is justified.

Accordingly, this instant appeal case is **Disposed of** and **closed**.
