1. The RTI application is dated **8.5.2019** vide which the appellant has sought information **regarding FIR No. 0030 dated 9.3.2019**, as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **12.5.2020** and second appeal was filed in the Commission on **17.9.2020** under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
