2. The appellant has filed his submissions that "after waiting for more than two and half hours, PA did not bother, neither had he arranged any inspection, nor meeting with Joint Commissioner, hence no inspection could be done."

3. The respondent is absent today.

4. The perusal of the file shows that the respondent has not complied with the orders of the Commission. This shows that the respondent has no regard for the orders issued by the Commission. This is indeed a serious matter. In view of the above, *PIO- respondent is directed to* show cause in writing or through affidavit under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act, as to why penalty be not imposed upon him for willful delay/ denial of the information to the RTI applicant and why the compensation be not awarded to the complainant under Section 19 (8)(b) of the Act for detriment suffered.
