In compliance to the bailable warrants, the APIO-SP (Investigation), Ferozepur has sent a mail to the Commission on 07.05.2021, diarized vide no.10085, which is a copy of letter no.269/RTI-1 dated 04.05.2021 along with a report dated 22.04.2021 of Police Station, Ghal Khurd.

I have gone through letter no.269/RTI-1 dated 04.05.2021 and it is submitted by the SP(Investigation), Ferozepur that ASI Anwar Masih has submitted the compliance report regarding the Bailable warrants of Shri Parminder Singh, SPIO-cum-BDPO, Ghal Khurd and he

has reported that Shri Parminder Singh was not present in the office, but Shri Raj Singh, Patwari was present and he has intimated Shri Parminder Singh through telephone regarding the bailable warrant and Shri Parminder Singh assured that he will come present along with the relevant record on 27.05.2021.

But today none has appeared on behalf of the respondents.

I have gone through Order dated 12.01.2021 and 10.03.2021 vide which the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Ferozepur was directed to deduct the amount of penalty of Rs.12,500/- each from the salary of Shri Parminder Singh, SPIO-cum-BDPO, Ghal Khurd and Shri Nirmaljit Singh, PIO-cum-Panchayat Secretary, Gram Panchayat, Ratta Khera Punjab Singh and to send compliance report to the Commission, but till date no compliance report has been sent to the Commission by the DDPO regarding the deposit of penalty.

So, the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Ferozepur is directed that it would be his responsibility to deduct the amount of penalty of Rs.12,500/- each be from the salary of Shri Parminder Singh, SPIO-cum-BDPO, Ghal Khurd and Shri Nirmaljit Singh, PIO-cum-Panchayat Secretary, Gram Panchayat, Ratta Khera Punjab Singh and be deposited in the Government Treasury in the following heads and compliance report be sent back to the Commission before the next date of hearing :-

A copy of the Order be sent to the Director, Rural Development and Panchayats Department, Mohali through registered post for strict compliance of the Order of the Commission.

I have gone through letter no.961 dated 05.04.2021 vide which the attested copies of information was sent to the appellant.

As the counsel of the appellant stated that incomplete information has been sent by the SPIO, so the appellant is directed that he should submit the list of deficiencies in writing to the notice of the SPIO within 3 days and the SPIO is further directed that in case the appellant would submit the deficiencies, then the attested copies of information regarding the deficiencies be sent to the appellant through registered post within 5 days from the receipt of deficiencies and compliance be sent to the Commission accordingly. Non compliance of the Order of the Commission would be viewed seriously and action would be taken against the SPIO under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.
