I have gone through the said statement and it is submitted by him that he has received complete information and he is satisfied and he further requested to close the case.

A show cause notice was issued to the SPIO vide order dated 31.08.2021 but the reply has not been sent by the SPIO regarding the show cause notice. But as the SPIO has provided the sought for information to the appellant and the appellant is also satisfied with the sought for information so the show cause notice issued to the SPIO is also dropped.

As the SPIO has provided the sought for information to the appellant and the appellant is also satisfied so the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed.**
