5. The Bench notes with concern the submissions made by the appellant and is in agreement with him and expresses its displeasure on the way the public dealing is done by GMADA. The Bench also deems it appropriate to advise the Chief Administrator, GMADA to get the matter looked into as it points to corruption and to see that the general public is not subjected to harassment and to ensure that the grievances of the public are redressed on priority.

In view of the above, the Bench does not feel need for further intervention in the matter.
