The appellant is absent today, whereas the respondent is present and he stated that the attested copies of information regarding the deficiencies pointed out by the appellant have been sent to him and copy of the same has been sent to the Commission.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 22.02.2021, a show cause notice was issued to the SPIO, O/o SSP Mohali and he was directed to file reply to the show cause notice. As per the reply submitted the SPIO it is clear that the SPIO is not personally liable for the delay in providing the information to the appellant, so the show cause notice issued to him is hereby dropped and filed.

As the SPIO has provided the sought for information to the appellant, so the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed.**
