First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter called FAA) on 24.8.2020 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 29.10.2020 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter called RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for today.

2. The appellant states that the respondents be directed to supply the complete information in this case. However, the respondent-Public Information Officer states that the information cannot be supplied in accordance with Section 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act. He has also sent the written submissions in this regard, which is taken on record.

3. The submissions made by the respondent-Public Information Officer are reproduced below:-

ORDER

The RTI application is dated 25.7.2020 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter called FAA) on 24.8.2020 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 29.10.2020 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter called RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for today.

2. The appellant contended that the information pertaining to Point No. 1 & 3 of the RTI application (appointment of JDM, DM (Draftsman) HDM (Head Draftsman) ATP, Building Inspectors along with their reservations etc.) has not been supplied by the respondent-Public Information Officer. However, the representative of the respondents states that the information is not readily available in the office and there is no provisions under the RTI Act, 2005 to create the information.

3. It is appropriate to mention the decision given by the Supreme Court of India in the matter of Central Board of Secondary Education & Anr. Vs. Aditya Bandopadhyay & Ors (Civil Appeal No.6454 of 2011) reported as 2011(3)RCT(Civil).

Relevant portion of the judgement is reproduced below:-

"The RTI Act should not be allowed to be misused or abused, to become a tool to

obstruct the national development and integration, or to destroy the peace, tranquillity and harmony among its citizens- Nor should it be converted into a tool of oppression or intimidation of honest officials striving to do their duty-National does not want a scenario where 75% of the staff of public authorities spends 75% of their time in collection and furnishing information to applicants instead of discharging their regular duties----Indiscriminate and impractical demands or directions under RTI Act for disclosure of all the sundry information (unrelated to transparency and accountability in the functioning of public authorities and eradication of corruption) would be counter-productive as it will adversely affect the efficiency of the administration and result in the executive getting bogged down with the non-productive work of collecting and furnishing information”.

4. Keeping in view the above, the Commission accepts the plea taken by the respondent-Public Information Officer and further observes that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed.
