ORDER

1. The above mentioned which was not heard on 06.07.2021 due to technical issue and matter was fixed for further hearing on 28.07.2021 i.e. today.
2. In today's hearing, respondent, Sh. Narinder Singh (Clerk) states that appellant had not supplied IFSC code till date, so compensation could not be paid to the appellant. He adds that appellant had returned the earlier provided demand draft.
3. Appellant is absent without any intimation to the Commission.
