The Commission has received an e-mail sent by the SPIO, which is a copy of letter no.315 dated 23.08.2021 and the above mentioned facts have been submitted by the SPIO in the letter.

As per the reply of the respondent that the information sought by the appellant is under consideration before the National Commission for Scheduled Castes, New Delhi, so the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed** with the direction to the SPIO that whenever the report in the concerned case will be received from the National Commission for Scheduled Castes, New Delhi, then the attested copies of sought for information be sent to the appellant through registered post within 15 days and compliance be sent to the Commission.
