ORDER

1. This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 18.12.2018.
2. Respondent, Sh. Rajesh Kumar states that only section 154 of C.R.P.C is available in the official record. He added that he has brought the attested copy of the requisite information relates with rules to hand it over to the appellant but he is not present.

He submits a reply vide letter no. 171 dated 24.01.2019 signed by Assistant Inspector General of Police, Vigilance Bureau, Flying Squad, Punjab, Mohali along with attested copy of 154 of C.R.P.C, stating that "Vigilance Bureau, Punjab conducts traps on corrupt public servants and arrest them red handed while accepting bribe. It also conducts investigations of corruption cases, disproportionate assets cases and cases of misuse of official position registered against public servants. Officers of the Bureau, who are basically Police Officers, have the obligatory powers under section 154 of C.R.P.C to register FIRs. Cases are registered mainly under various relevant sections of Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 and Indian Penal Code". It is taken on record.

3. Respondent, Sh. Rajesh Kumar also intimated the Commission that address of the respondent is changed and correct address is Vigilance Bureau, Sector-68, SAS Nagar.

4. Appellant, Sh. Prem Kumar Rattan is not present for today's hearing but an email dated 28.01.2019 has been received from the appellant by the Bench of Undersigned stating that he is unable to attend today's hearing. This mail is taken on record.

5. After hearing the respondent and examining the documents placed on record, we are of the considered view that brought reply is satisfactory and respondent, Sh. Rajesh Kumar is directed to send the brought information to the appellant through registered post and send a copy of postal receipt to the Commission. Therefore, no further cause of action is required in this case. Hence, the instant appeal case is **disposed of & closed**. Copy of this order be sent to the respondent PIO on the correct address as he informed during the hearing.

ORDER

1. This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 18.12.2018.
2. Appellant, Dr. Ravi Jindal states that he is not satisfied with the supplied reply and states that letter dated 03.10.2017 and 06.10.2017 is different. He also mentioned that requisite information relates with point no. 7 through which copy of action taken on my letter dated 03.10.2017 along with copy of file notings.
3. Respondent, Ms. Gurmeet Kaur states that matter is pending in their office so requisite information cannot be supplied to the appellant. She added that matter is same of both the letters dated 03.10.2017 and 06.10.2017. She submits a reply vide letter no. 237 dated 28.01.2019 signed by the Deputy Director-cum-State Nodal Officer (PNDT), Punjab, which is taken on record.
4. After hearing both the parties and examining the case file, we observed that submitted reply is not satisfactory and one more opportunity is given to the respondent PIO to supply the proper reply along with file notings to the appellant within three days along with directions to bring the same to put before the Commission on the next date of hearing positively.
5. Both the parties are also advised to be present on the next date of hearing to clear the facts of this case.
6. Matter is adjourned for further hearing on **13.02.2019 at 12:00 Noon**.
