Present:- Shri Sandeep Kumar Maluja, complainant/applicant is absent.

O R D E R

Shri Sandeep Kumar Maluja, complainant/applicant filed RTI application dated 27.02.2020 and sought information from the SPIO, O/o DFSC, Fazilka regarding the allotment of free kerosene oil.

Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Meetings Software. Both the parties are absent today.

I have gone through the Order dated 16.02.2021 and on that date both the parties were present. The respondent stated that the complainant-applicant sought information regarding the allotment of free kerosene oil, but no free kerosene oil has been allotted to the office of DFSC, Fazilka, so the SPIO was directed that he should submit in writing that no free kerosene oil has been allotted to the office of DFSC, Fazilka and send the same to the complainant/applicant as well as to the Commission within a week.

In compliance to the Order dated 16.02.2021, the SPIO has sent a mail to the Commission on 23.03.2021, diarized vide no.6697, which is a copy of letter no.674 dated 17.03.2021. I have gone through the said letter and it is submitted by the SPIO that for the period 01.01.2019 to 06.02.2020 on the occasion of 550 birth celebration no free kerosene oil has been allotted to district Fazilka.

I have gone through the RTI application dated 27.02.2020 filed by the complainant/applicant and also gone through the reply sent by the SPIO. The applicant sought information regarding free kerosene oil for the period 01.01.2019 to 06.02.2020 on the occasion of 550 birth celebration and the SPIO has replied that for the period 01.01.2019 to 06.02.2020 on the occasion of 550 birth celebration no free kerosene oil has been allotted to district Fazilka.

The SPIO has resolved the matter involved in the RTI application, so the present complaint case is **disposed of and closed**.
