ORDER:

The appellant through RTI application dated 29.06.2020 has sought information on 08 points regarding departmental promotion of multipurpose health supervisors in 10/2018 – a copy of pay register(complete salary statements) of health supervisors for the months 5/2019 to 06.2020 along with DA arrears to supervisors from 10/18 to 06/2020 and other information as enumerated in the RTI application concerning the office of SMO-PHC Dudhan Sadhan, Distt.Patiala. The appellant was asked to vide letter dated 20.07.2020 by PIO to deposit requisite fee of Rs.200/- which the appellant did not deposit and filed the first appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 16.11.2020, which took no decision on the appeal. After filing the first appeal, the PIO sent information to the appellant vide letter dated 24.11.2020 to which the appellant was not satisfied and filed 2nd appeal in the Commission on 09.03.2021.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Ludhiana. As per the respondent, the information has already been provided to the appellant vide letter dated 24.11.2020, 05.12.2020 and 29.06.2021. As per the appellant, the information is incomplete and not legible nor attested.

Hearing both the parties, the Commission directs the appellant to inspect the record on 02.08.2020 at 10.00 AM by visiting the office of PIO and get the deficiency resolved. The PIO is directed to allow inspection of the record on the given date and time and provide the appellant with the deficient information. It may be made clear that only that information needs to be provided, which has been sought in the RTI application.

ORDER:

The appellant through RTI application dated 18.04.2020 has sought information regarding details of Prime Minister Jan Aushdhi Store in Ludhiana, Amritsar, Jalandhar & Patiala from 2017 to 18.04.2020 - list of documents required for getting Jan Aushdhi Store – supply of generic medicines to store and other information as enumerated in the RTI application concerning the office of Food and Drug Administrator, Kharar. The appellant was not provided with the information after which the appellant filed the first appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 21.06.2020, which took no decision on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Ludhiana. As per the respondent, they have already issued instructions to the office of the Civil Surgeon, Ludhiana, Amritsar, Patiala and Jalandhar and the information relating to District Ludhiana has already been supplied by the Drug Inspector Ludhiana to the appellant vide letter dated 07.08.2020 with a copy to the Commission. The respondent has also submitted a copy of the information supplied to the appellant by the Drug Control Officer, Patiala vide letter dated 16.09.2020. As per the respondent, the information from Amritsar and Jalandhar is yet to be supplied.

The appellant claims that there are four zones in Ludhiana and he has only received information from Zone-1 Ludhiana which is also incomplete.

A copy of information relating to Patiala District submitted by the respondent is being sent to the appellant. For the rest of the information, including deficiencies, the PIO-O/o Food & Drug Administration, Kharar is directed to procure the information from other zones of Ludhiana as well as from Amritsar & Jalandhar and provide it to the appellant within one month and send a compliance report to the commission.

ORDER:

The appellant through RTI application dated 26.10.2020 has sought information regarding details of official notings and proceedings in an email dated 30.09.2020 and 17.10.2020 regarding NABL Test Report and financial recoveries for overcharging Lab chemicals relating to CRM-M-12646 of 2019 – details or record verifying the amount of financial recovery for purchase of an overcharged price of Glycerol – Methanol and other information as enumerated in the RTI application concerning the office of Director, Health & Family Welfare c/o Stores Purchase Branch, Health Pb Chandigarh. The appellant was not provided with the information after which the appellant filed the first appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 15.12.2020, which took no decision on the appeal. After filing the first appeal, the PIO sent a reply vide letter dated 28.12.2020 that since the appellant has filed a case in the court, the reply will be given in the court.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Ludhiana. The respondent is present at Chandigarh and pleaded that no email was received and no record is available. The appellant claims -

That the PIO had earlier sent a reply vide letter dated 28.12.2020 that since the appellant has filed a case in the court, the reply will be given in the court only.

That whereas now the PIO has sent a different reply vide letter dated 19.07.2021 stating that the information is not available.

That there are two different replies a) that the record is available; b) that the record is not available.

From the above arguments, prima facie it appears that the sought information could well exist in the custody of the concerned public authority.

I hereby direct the PIO to relook at the RTI information and provide all the information point-wise. If any of the information is not available as stated in the reply, file a suitable reply on an affidavit.
