On the other hand, PIO, Sh. Manohar Singh states that he has recently joined the office and he is unaware of the facts of this case and further requests for a date and also requests the Court to announce a new date for inspection as well.

Commission takes a very serious view of the casual approach of the PIO, as still incomplete information has been supplied to the Appellant.

In view of the above, a show cause notice under Section 20 (1) of the RTI Act is issued to the 'concerned' PIO O/o The Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Mullanpur Dakha (District Ludhiana (Pb.)) as to why penalty be not imposed upon him for willful delay in supplying the information to the RTI Appellant and as to why the compensation be not awarded to the information-seeker under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005

In addition, the PIO is also hereby given an opportunity under Section 20(1) provision thereto, for a personal hearing with the sought for information, before the imposition of such penalty on the next date of hearing.

After discussing with both the parties, it has been decided that the Appellant will visit the concerned office on **02.11.2020** at **11:00** A.M. for collecting the specific information after

inspecting the records. Sh. Manohar Singh, PIO and other concerned officials are directed to be present there on the said date and time to facilitate the Appellant and to supply the record.

If the Appellant doesn't visit on the said date and time then it will be presumed that the Appellant is satisfied and he doesn't require the information anymore and the case will be decided on merits.

The PIO is further directed to supply the requisite information to the Appellant by hand when he visits at their concerned office on 02.11.2020, failing which an action would be taken against the PIO.

This case is adjourned to '22.12.2020 at 11:00 A.M.' and both the parties are directed to be present on the next date of hearing i.e. 22.12.2020, which is going to be heard through Video Conference Software/ Application Cisco Webex Meetings.
