Since the complainant has approached the Commission under the provisions of Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission.

An alternative and efficacious remedy of first appeal is available to the complainant under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 which has not been availed in the instant case. The matter is remanded to the First Appellate Authority to take appropriate decision after hearing both the parties and examining the record brought on file.

The parties shall appear before the First Appellate Authority-cum-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana on 26.10.2021 at 11:00 A.M. who will decide the matter in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act within the prescribed timeline, after giving opportunity of hearing to all concerned by passing a speaking order.
