The RTI request is dated 08.12.2018. First appeal is dated 11.03.2019. Second
appeal has been received in the Commission on 19.08.2019.

On the last date of hearing, held on 14.07.2021 ;

- i) Sh. Shyam Lal, Assistant Transport Officer, stated that in response to the RTI request, the requisite information was supplied to the appellant in C D form.
- ii) The respondent PIO had not sent any document, which shows that the penalty amount of Rs. 5000/- which was imposed upon him vide order dated 18.01.2021, is deposited.
- iii) Last and final opportunity was given to the respondent PIO concerned to comply with the order dated 18.01.2021 passed by the Commission by paying penalty of Rs. 5,000/- in the Treasury of Punjab Government and send a copy of challan receipt to the Commission.

The appellant, Sh. Shakti Bhushan, who appeared in person in today's hearing, states that incomplete information has been supplied to him by the respondent PIO.

As on the hearing, held on 26.04.2021, an opportunity was given to the appellant to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO so that the same could be removed by the respondent concerned and the case was adjourned for 14.07.2021 but neither he (the appellant) was present on the hearing, held on 14.07.2021 nor pointed any deficiency in the supplied information to the respondent or to the Commission and today(29.09.2021).
