The complaint/applicant is absent without any intimation to the Commission, whereas the PIO has come present.

The complainant/applicant filed RTI application dated 27.09.2018 and sought information regarding attested copies of service book of Shri Davinder Kumar, S/o Shri Bant Ram, Ticket Verifier. The PIO wrote letter no.9023 dated 29.10.2018 and the information sought by the complainant/applicant was denied being personal information of Shri Davinder Kumar. It is submitted in the letter that the RTI application dated 27.09.2018 was received in the office of the PIO on 01.10.2018 and the PIO sent the reply to the complainant/applicant within the stipulated period i.e. on 29.10.2018.

As the PIO has acted upon the RTI application and sent the reply to the complainant/applicant within the stipulated period of 30 days, so, no complaint lies against the PIO. The remedy lies with the complainant/applicant that in case he wants to file First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority then he can file First Appeal within 30 days before the First Appellate Authorities i.e. Director, State Transport Punjab. With this observation the present complaint case is **disposed of and closed**.
