Government, Punjab(Trust Services Cell) to send a proper written reply to the appellant through registered post with a copy to the Commission, stating that the required information is not found available in the official record, mentioning the reasons whether official record is missing or destroyed and if destruction of record has been done, a copy of Office-order (if destruction of record has been done) be sent, by the next date of hearing.

As the RTI request of the complainant is addressed to PIO office of Principal Secretary to Government. of Punjab, Deptt. of Local Government but neither the respondent PIO nor any of his representative is present in today's hearing. He has also not sent any intimation regarding his non-availability. The Commission took a serious view of this casual approach of the respondent PIO.

In view of the above, a show cause notice under Section 20 (1) of the RTI Act is issued to Public Information Officer concerned of office of Principal Secretary to Government. of Punjab, Deptt. of Local Government, as to why penalty be not imposed upon him for willful delay/denial in supplying the information to the RTI applicant under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

He may note that in case he does not file his submission and does not avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date fixed through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings', it will be presumed that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceedings against him ex-parte. A copy of this order be sent to him through registered post.
