ORDER

Shri Lal Chand Virhe, appellant filed RTI application dated 13.07.2020 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o S.H.O., Police Station (NRI), Ludhiana. When no information was provided to him by the SPIO, then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 03.10.2020 and then Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 03.11.2020. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today through **CISCO Webex Meetings Software**.

The appellant is present today and H.C. Sukhdeep Singh, O/o ADGP (NRI Wing), Mohali is present.

The appellant stated that no information has been provided to him by the SPIO.

The Respondent stated that that the appellant has filed RTI application before SHO, Police Station, NRI Wing, Ludhiana, but the said application was forwarded to the office of the ADGP, NRI Wing, Mohali for further necessary action. He further stated that the appellant sought information regarding case no. 19 dated 30.08.2018, which cannot be provided to him U/s 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act, 2005 as the investigation is still pending in the said case and the reply regarding this has already been sent to the appellant vide letter no.24410 dated 10.09.2020.

As the investigation regarding the information sought by the appellant is still pending, so the information cannot be provided U/s 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act, 2005. Hence, the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed** with the observation that whenever the investigation will be completed, the attested copies of sought for information be sent to the appellant through registered post within 15 days and compliance report be sent to the Commission.
