Shri Dharam Singh, appellant filed RTI application dated 03.01.2019 and sought some information from the PIO, O/o Tehsildar, Tarn Taran. When no information was provided to him by the PIO, then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 02.03.2019. Then he filed Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 06.09.2019. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. It shows that he has no respect for the Commission and the law.

Appeal Case No. 3319 of 2019

The appellant stated that he has filed RTI application on 03.01.2019, but no information has been provided to him by the office of the PIO, whereas a period of 10 months has been passed.

The PIO is duty bound to provide the sought for information to the applicant within the stipulated period of 30 days, but in the present case a period of 10 months has been passed and the appellant is suffering from the hands of the PIO. So, an amount of Rs.5,000/- is awarded as compensation in favour of the appellant to be paid by the PIO by the way of demand draft from the funds of public authority i.e. Tehsildar, Tarn Taran and be sent through registered post at the address of the appellant within a week.

Shri Karanbir Singh, PIO-cum-Tehsildar, Tarn Taran is directed that the attested copies of information sought by the appellant be sent to him through registered post within a week. In case of non compliance of the Order of the Commission a Show Cause Notice will be issued to the PIO on the next date of hearing.

Both the parties should personally come present on the next date of hearing on **27.11.2019 at 11:00 A.M.**

On the other hand, the respondents have come present and stated that the information sought by the appellant through point nos.1, 2 and 3 of RTI application is available on the Website i.e. www.mcludhiana.gov.in. and is open for the public domain and the appellant is at liberty to download the information from the Website and the information regarding point no. 4 of the RTI application had already been sent to her.

As the PIO has resolved the matter involved in the RTI application and the appellant has not come present inspite of directions issued to her. So, the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed**.
