3. Copy of the 10 Examination Forms filled by the Candidate Harlove Singh Rajput having registration number 6112-14-163 from the year 2014 till 2019.
4. If copy is not maintained of the Examination Forms filled by the Candidates, whether any alternative record is maintained? Whether the Examination Forms are scanned and saved by the University?
5. Kindly provide Information as to provision of University Calendar/Ordinance/Statute or Notification or Regulation or any rule under which DMCs are issued in respect of the Examination Forms filled by the Candidate.
6. Kindly provide Information as to relevant provision of University Calendar/Ordinance/Statute or Notification or Regulation or any rule under which DMCs and Degrees are corrected, if any mistake is apparent on DMCs/Degree.
7. Whether DMCs/Degrees are printed keeping in view the particulars of Examination Forms or 12th Class DMC?
8. Kindly provide with the liability of Staff/Clerk/official who entered wrong information on DMCs/Degrees or omitted to print the same or added into the name particulars of Candidate or his family.
9. Kindly provide copy of the notification/rule/regulation under which University charges fee for correction of DMCs.
10. Whether the mistake committed/omitted by the University Official/staff/clerk in printing or entering particulars of a Candidate in Degree/DMCs will be liable to any action? And whether the student has to pay for correcting the same when a dispute is raised at a later/belated stage.
11. How is First Semester DMC prepared, with particulars, by University of a candidate passing examination successfully? How is the Information as to Mothers' Name, father's Name of a candidate is taken and printed on DMCs?
12. How is Transcript prepared and sent to Universities/NCA/WES from University? Purpose of Transcripts? Manner in which they are sent. Why are not DMCs issued by University not able to serve the purpose of verification? What all is seen by University for verification of DMCs for the purpose of Transcript.
13. Kindly provide with the actual cost of preparation of Transcripts for a student of B.A.LL.B. who has 10 DMCs with 1 Degree of Bachelor of Arts (Law) and 1 degree of Bachelor of Laws (5 Years Course). If the fee charged is more than the cost incurred, where is the balance amount adjusted by the University?

3. The appellant informed telephonically that the appropriate action has already been taken by the Punjabi University, Patiala with which he is satisfied. He further states that he has no objection if the present case is disposed of and closed.

“Hon’ble Supreme Court of India in its order rendered on 12.12.2011 in Civil Appeal Nos.10787 – 10788 of 2011 (arising out of SLP © No.32768-32769/2010) has held that while entertaining a complaint under Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information. Since the complainant has approached the Commission under the provisions of Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission. ”

4. But due to negligence of dealing with the RTI application of the appellant, the penalty was imposed upon the SPIO o/o Block Development and Panchayats Officer

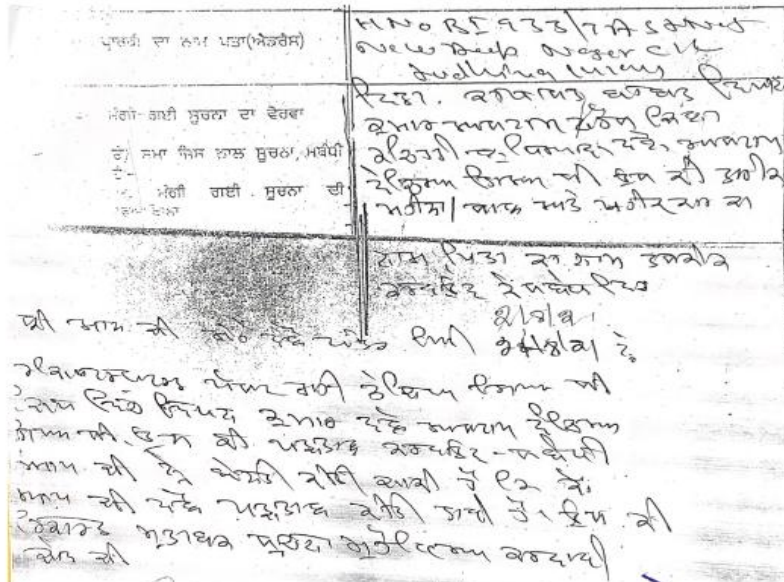

ORDER

The RTI application is dated 14.7.2021 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter called FAA) on 8.9.2021 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 2.12.2021 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter called RTI Act).
